

# PartiCraft

## Project Sheet: Family Moments



### What you need:

- Meadow Scrapbook paper
- Fancy pants ribbon – blue
- Brown Card stock
- Cream cardstock
- Radiant Rain – nutmeg
- Distress ink – Walnut Stain
- Cut'n'dry foam
- Dries Clear adhesive
- Foam pads
- Paint brush
- Photo (the photo used in this Layout is 12cm x 18cm)
- Craft Knife
- Kitchen roll of tissue

### INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut a 12cm x 18cm rectangle from your cream card stock and cover the edges in Nutmeg radiant rain and put to one side to dry.
2. Lay your photo onto the Meadow Scrapbook paper and see where you can cut along some of the petals – use the above picture as a guide.
3. Cut along the petals of some of the flowers and curl them slightly to add depth.
4. Remove one of the flowers that would be underneath the photo making sure that the cut will be completely hidden once the photo is adhered.
5. Adhere the cream cardstock onto the Meadow paper using dries clear adhesive.
6. Add a small amount of blue ribbon onto the right-hand bottom corner of your photo creating a photo corner and adhere the ribbon at the back of the photo using the dries clear adhesive.
7. Adhere the photo on top of the cream cardstock but at a slight angle using dries clear adhesive
8. Adhere the overlapping petals onto the photo with foam pads.
9. Adhere the cut out flower to the right-hand top corner again with foam pads.
10. Cut out a tag shape from your remaining cream cardstock.
11. Dip your paint brush into the Nutmeg radiant rain and splatter onto the tag.
12. Dab the splattered radiant rain with some kitchen roll or tissue.
13. Transfer some Walnut stain distress ink onto your Cut'n'Dry foam and blend into the edges of the tag – your tag is now ready to journal on.
14. Write your title in reverse onto the back of your brown cardstock, if you are not confident using your own handwriting use your computer to print out your title, cut out the individual letters and then place it reverse onto your cardstock and trace around.
15. Cut out the letters.
16. Cover the letters in Nutmeg Radiant Rain and set aside to dry.
17. Adhere the letters using Dries Clear adhesive then trace around the edges using the butterscotch Adirondack pen.
18. Transfer some Walnut Stain Distress ink onto your Cut'n'Dry foam and blend onto the edges of your meadow paper.
19. Tie the remaining blue ribbon around the left-hand side of the page and adhere at the back with dries clear adhesive.
20. Attach the tag partly underneath the ribbon using dries clear adhesive.
