

Project Sheet: Tree and Moon



What you need:

- Unmounted Stamp Plate - Nature
- Acrylic Block & UMOUNT
- Walnut Stain Distressing Ink
- Cut 'n' Dry Foam
- Archival Black Ink
- Perfect Medium Pad
- Clear Embossing Powder
- Gold Embossing Powder
- Dries Clear Glue
- Metal Applicator Tip
- Aurora Glitter
- Something circular to draw around
- Tidy Tray
- Purple Cow Cutter
- 12x12 Brown Card
- Cream A4 Card
- Eazi-Score Board
- 3D Foam Pads
- Stamp Cleaner
- Heat Tool
- Scissors

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Create an A5 card from your brown card stock, using the Eazi-Score board.
- 2) Ink up the corner stamp with the perfect medium pad, stamp into the top left hand corner of your folded card, cover with gold embossing powder and heat. Remember to work over a tidy tray to catch the excess and put back in the pot. Repeat on the bottom right corner of the card.
- 3) Trim a piece of cream cardstock to approx 9.5 x 13.5 cm and round the edges with your scissors. Using something circular (e.g. a bottle or something approx 4cm in diameter) draw around it onto a post it note or scrap of paper and temporarily stick to the top right of your cream card.
- 4) Now using your cut n dry foam and the walnut stain ink pad distress the card all over, don't worry about going over your paper circle as long as it does not lift. When you have finished lift off your paper circle.
- 5) Now ink the tree stamp with black archival ink, stamp down so that some of the branches appear in the cream circle. To apply some texture to the tree, clean the stamp well, re ink with perfect medium and stamp over the top of your original black tree. Apply clear embossing powder over the perfect medium pad and heat.
- 6) Run the edges of the card through the perfect medium pad, apply gold embossing powder and heat.
- 7) To create some interest, use your dries clear glue and apply a thin line around the outer edge of your cream circle (it should resemble a moon now). Also apply some dots and accents to the tree. Now tip over the aurora glitter, tap off the excess and allow to dry.
- 8) Using your dries clear glue attach this piece to cream card. You may find it easier to attach your finished piece to the cream card so that you have two narrow edges then trim the rest of the card so that you have the same cream border all the way around. If you don't want to work this way then simply cut a piece of cream card so that it is slightly bigger all the way around than your base image. Remember to round the edges with your scissors.
- 9) Attach this whole piece to your base card with 3D foam pads.
