

Project Sheet: Gingham Heart



What you need:

- A4 White Card
- Eazi-Score Board
- Black archival Ink
- U-Mount Set – Birthday
- U-Mount
- Fancy Pants 'Free Spirit' Ribbons
- Fancy Pants 'Free Spirit' Emma Paper
- Dries Clear Glue and Nib
- Easy Lift Tape
- 3D Foam Pads
- Purple Cow Trimmer
- Acrylic Block

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Begin by placing your A4 sheet of white card tall ways on your scoring board and score on line 6 (A5 Half Fold) from top to bottom. Cut along this line. Now turn the cut card 360° so that it is long ways on the board and score along line 7 (A6 Half Fold). Fold along the new crease and you have your A6 'landscape' base card.
- 2) Take the 'Emma' paper and place on the scoring board and score along line 1 then cut.
- 3) Use glue or easy lift tape to stick the paper you have just cut, gingham side up, across the middle of the card then trim the excess.
- 4) Using the Archival Black Ink, stamp the heart image from the Birthday U-Mount set four times, once onto the gingham side of the backing paper, once onto the green side, and twice onto plain white card.
- 5) Cut out the full gingham heart and set to one side – this will be the base layer of our topper.
- 6) Next cut out one of the white hearts up to the second heart in, we are now going to cut out the third heart in from the green paper and stick on top of the white heart. This should leave a white border showing around the green. Finally cut out just the flowers and leaves from the last white heart (you could just ink this section up and stamp to save card) and stick this on top of the flower and leaves on the green heart.
- 7) Glue the base gingham heart onto the centre of your card.
- 8) Attach some 3D foam pads to the now glued centre detail of the heart and place it in the middle of the gingham one to complete the topper.
- 9) Cut a 10cm piece of the blue ribbon from the Fancy Pants pack and tie a loose knot in the centre. Attach this to the top left of your complete heart using some easy lift tape.
