Project Sheet: Floral Congratulations



What you need:

- Unmounted Stamp Plate - Birthday
- Acrylic Block & UMOUNT
- Cream A4 Card
- Distress Ink Walnut Stain
- Dries Clear Glue with Metal Applicator
- Bronze Glitter
- Purple Cow Cutter
- Eazi - Score Board
- Fancy Pants Paper Mulberry Road - Pemberley
- 3D Foam
- Tidy Tray
- Pencil
- Scissors

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Start by cutting an A4 sheet of Cream card in half. Score and fold to make an A6 base card.
- 2) Place the folded card on the 12x12 paper and mark its parameters with a pencil so that you will know where the edge of the card comes to. Draw another line horizontally across the middle of the longest side.
- 3) Ink up the flower stamp and stamp along the edge of the middle pencil line on the coral coloured side of the 12x12 paper trying to keep the images more or less in a line to create a border.
- 4) Trim out cutting quite close to the border of flowers so that you get their shape.
- 5) Apply glue to the other side and attach to your card stock as close to the folded line as possible.
- 6) Ink up the congratulations stamp and stamp above the border of flowers.
- 7) Stamp out at least 7 spare flowers. Allow all your stamping to dry (this should only take a few seconds)
- 8) Apply dries clear glue to the middles and a few accent lines of each flower and pop on the bronze glitter, work over a tidy tray so you can put all the excess glitter back in the pot.
- 9) Trim out leaving 3 flowers whole and the others single.
- 10) Pop 3D foam on the back of 5 of the flowers and position over the original stamped ones.
- 11) On the last two mini flowers use a little bit of glue and attach to each corner of the card.
