

Project Sheet: Fibre Lilies



What you need:

- Unmounted Stamp Plate - Bears
- Acrylic Block & UMOUNT
- Black A4 Card
- Perfect Medium
- Gold Embossing Powder
- Heat Gun
- Cosmic Shimmer Watercolour Paint - Brights
- No.2 Brush
- Water
- Purple Cow
- Score Board
- Garden Twist Fibre Pack
- Iron
- Parchment Paper
- Archival Black Ink Pad
- Tidy Tray
- 3D Foam Pads

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Start by cutting an A4 sheet of black card in half. Score and fold to make a gate fold A6 base card.
- 2) Run the edges of your card through the perfect medium pad and cover with gold embossing powder and heat. Remember to work over a tidy tray so you can pop all the excess back in the pot.
- 3) On a spare piece of black card ink the Lily Stamp with perfect medium and stamp down, cover with gold powder and heat. Trim out the design.
- 4) Colour your lily with the cosmic shimmer water colour paints. Apply glue to the back on one side only and attach to the left hand gate of your card.
- 5) Allow your iron to heat up to a medium setting (remember to turn off the steam setting)
- 6) Tease out some of the orange fibre from the pack. Make sure you have enough by testing the size on your stamp.
- 7) Ink the stamp with the black ink pad.
- 8) Place the fibre directly on top taking care not to move it about.
- 9) Place your piece of parchment paper on top and iron.
- 10) Allow to cool for a few seconds and trim out.
- 11) Use 3D foam to attach this to your base card.
