Project Sheet: Just For You



What you need:

- Unmounted Stamp Plate – Bears
- Acrylic Block & UMOUNT
- Walnut Stain Distressing Ink
- Cut 'n' Dry Foam
- Gold Embossing Powder
- Perfect Medium Ink Pad
- Heat Gun
- Adirondack Pigment Pens
- Purple Cow Cutter
- 'Dries Clear' Glue and Metal Applicator
- No.2 Round Brush
- Water
- A4 Cream Card
- Tile or plate
- Craft Knife

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Start by cutting an A4 sheet of cream card in half and folding to make an A6 base card.
- 2) Using the same shade of cream card, stamp your geranium image in walnut distressing ink then trim to slightly smaller than the A6 card size.
- 3) Scribble some ink from your Adirondack Pigment Pens onto an old tile or plate. This will be your palette for colouring the image.
- 4) Wet your paintbrush and dilute some colour on your palette and begin to shade your geranium. The Walnut ink you used to stamp with will bleed, but this will work well by muting the colours and giving a more vintage feel.
- 5) When you've finished colouring the geranium use your craft knife to scratch around the edges, then shade using the cut 'n' dry foam and walnut ink. This will give a 'cracked tile' effect to your project.
- 6) On a new strip of cream card which has been trimmed to approximately 1cm deep, stamp and emboss the 'just for you' wording using perfect medium and gold embossing powder. Shade along the top and bottom with the walnut ink and cut'n'dry foam.
- 7) Using 'dries clear' glue and applicator, stick the wording strip towards the bottom of the geranium topper and trim off excess at each side then glue to the cream base card.
