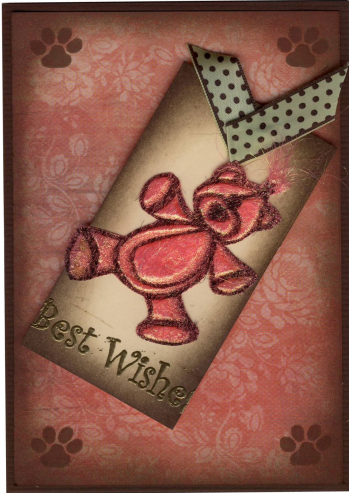


Project Sheet: Teddy Tag Card



What you need:

- Garden Twist Cosmic Shimmer Glitter Fibres
- Black Archival Ink
- A5 Parchment
- Iron (dry with no steam setting)
- 12x12 Brown Card
- Fancy Pants 'Free Spirit' Meadow paper
- Fancy Pants 'Free Spirit' Ribbon
- A4 Cream Card
- Bears U-Mount unmounted stamp set
- Walnut Distress Ink
- Cut 'n' Dry Foam
- Perfect Medium Ink Pad
- Gold Embossing Powder
- Heat Tool
- Purple Cows Cutter
- Scoring Board

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Begin by placing your Brown 12x12" card onto the score board and scoring along line 7. Cut along this line.
2. Take your cut card and turn it 360o so that it is portrait (long ways) across the score board and score along line 6 then fold.
3. Use your cutter to cut the long card piece to the same size as the shorter one, creating a normal A6 card.
4. Position the 'Meadow' paper on the score board and score along line 5 then cut. This creates a strip slightly narrower than the A6 card width. To create the same margin at the top and bottom, simply position the strip so that the left, right and top margins look the same against the main card, then by eye, make a small crease or nick with your finger nail to mark where you should trim at the bottom.
5. Take your 'Meadow' background and with the 'orangey' side up blend the walnut distress ink around the sides using the cut 'n' dry foam to create a subtle distressed edge.
6. Ink up the small paw print with brown distressing ink and stamp in all four corners of the background then stick this to the base card.
7. To create the tag, position your A4 cream card lengthways on the score board and score then cut along line 3, turn it 360o then score and cut along line 5. Distress around the edges with the Walnut Ink and Cut 'n' Dry as before.
8. Ink up the 'Best Wishes' stamp with Perfect Medium and stamp across base of tag. Sprinkle on the gold embossing powder, tip off the excess and heat with the heat tool to emboss.
9. Cut a piece of the Fancy Pants green spotty ribbon and fold then stick to the top of the tag using easy lift tape. Put the tag to one side while we make the teddy.
10. Take enough orange fibre to cover the teddy image and put to one side. Ink up the stamp with Archival Black Ink and place the fibre on top of the inked stamp which is face up on the table. Place the piece of parchment directly on top of the fibre and then hold the medium to hot dry iron onto this for several seconds until they fuse together.
11. Cut out the fibre bear, leaving a tuft at the top of his head for hair then stick at an angle to the prepared tag using Dries Clear Glue.
12. Attach the tag at an angle to the card using 3D foam pads.
