Stained Glass Butterfly

What you need:



- Stamp: RN139I
- Clear Perfect Medium Ink Pad
- Cardstock: White, Pink, Teal
- Embossing Powder: Black
- Twinkling H2O's: Chiffon Pink, Jasmine, Rick Cocoa, Sunburst, Yellow Rose, Key Lime, Sunburst, Bashful Blue, Sky Blue, heavenly White
- Paint Brush
- 3D Foam Pads
- Dries Clear Glue
- Cosmic Shimmer Aurora Sparkle Glitter
- Decorative Punch
- Glossy Accents

Instructions

1. Ink butterfly stained glass with clear perfect medium and stamp onto white cardstock. Emboss with black embossing powder.
2. Paint the entire image using a small paint brush with Twinkling H2O's. We have used chiffon pink, jasmine, rich cocoa and sunburst for the butterfly wings and body, yellow rose, key lime and sunburst for the flower, bashful blue for the inner background area and sky blue for the outer background rectangular area. Highlight all areas using heavenly white. Use shades that are slightly darker to blend shadow into the image for depth.
3. Using dries clear glitter glue, cover the inner background area then sprinkle aurora sparkle glitter and tap off.
4. Stamp and emboss just the upper wing area of the butterfly and cut out. Paint with Twinkling H2O's to match original. Apply a small amount of glue to the area of the wing nearest the body and attach to the original butterfly. Add some 3D foam pads to the underside of the wing to lift it up.
5. Cut out the entire stained glass around the edge and mount onto pink cardstock (match the card to the colour of the butterfly's wing). Leave an inch on either side and use your favourite punch to add a design to the edge on both sides of the card. Add a colour wash to each side with Twinkling H2O's in the same colour to match the cardstock.
6. Mount on to a piece of white cardstock and punch the corners with a decorative punch. Lastly mount it to a piece of teal cardstock to finish. Add glossy accents to the round dots on the butterfly's wings and let dry.
